VIENNA, AUSTRIA, 10-21 OCTOBER 2005

Place, date and time:

The Conference will be held at the United Nations Office in Vienna, Vienna International Centre, Wagramer Strasse 5, 1220 Vienna, in the Boardroom (C04), from 10-21 October 2005, beginning at 10:00 a.m.

Credentials of representatives:

The credentials of representatives of each State Party and the names of the persons constituting that State's delegation shall be issued either by the Head of State or Government or by the Minister for Foreign Affairs or, in exceptional cases, by a person authorized by either of them, or, in the case of a regional economic integration organization, by the competent authority of that organization.

The credentials should be submitted to the secretariat if possible not later than twenty-four hours in advance of the opening of the session.

Registration:

Participants may register for the Conference at the Registration Desk located in Gate 1 where all conference passes will be issued an hour before the opening of the session.

Transportation:

Participants are expected to arrange their own transportation to and from the Airport and the Conference Centre.

Visas:

Participants who require a visa for entry in Austria can secure their visas at the nearest Austrian diplomatic or consular office, or any diplomatic or consular authority of any State participating in the Schengen Agreement and acting on behalf of Austria. (Belgium, Germany, France, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal, Spain and Greece)

Hotel:

Participants are requested to make their own hotel arrangements or contact their Permanent Missions in Vienna for assistance.
