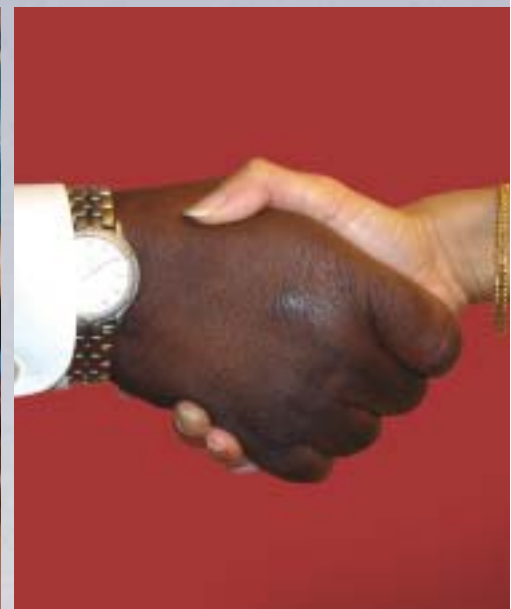




Delivering Legal Technical Assistance in Counter-Terrorism
