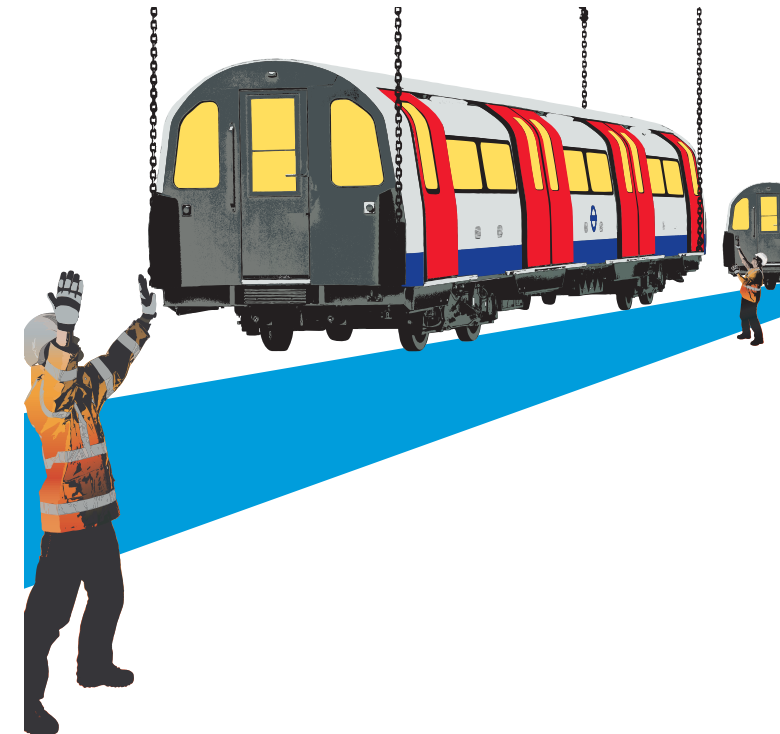

Victoria line early closures

Mondays to Thursdays after 2200, until late November

While we continue testing new trains, that will increase capacity and improve the service, the Victoria line will close early.

The improvements to the Victoria line and how they will affect you

Last year the closure programme on the Victoria line allowed us to successfully start replacing track and signals and start testing of new trains.

The first of the new trains will enter service later this year. The carriages will have CCTV, wheelchair access, better ventilation and improved visual and audio customer information systems.

There is still much to do and each evening, up to 1000 people will be working to deliver the upgrade. This work will not be confined just to the trains, track and signals. Stations such as Oxford Circus and Green Park are also undergoing modernisation work to improve ambience, information provision, safety and security features.

This leaflet details the series of evening and weekend closures which will allow us to continue upgrading your Victoria line. It also contains information to help you plan your journey.

The Victoria line is closed from 2200 on Monday - Thursday evenings until late November.

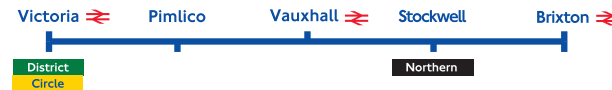
Weekend closures are detailed overleaf.

Oyster pay as you go customers

Customers will not be charged for using alternative Tube routes and replacement bus services. If you use local bus or National Rail services listed and are charged, or need to buy another ticket, call the Oyster helpline* on 0845 330 9876. There will be no refund for customers using local bus or National Rail services not listed here.

* Helpline is open from 8am - 8pm. For BT residential customers, calls to the Oyster Help Line will cost no more than 3.5p per minute, (current at November 2007). The price on non-BT phone lines may be different.

Last train times for the Victoria line

Should a major evening event such as a football match, take place near the line, a weekday early closure may be cancelled. Details of any such cancellation will be publicised closer to the date. Please check before you travel.
