- in Year 11 in 2008 and interested in the visual arts.

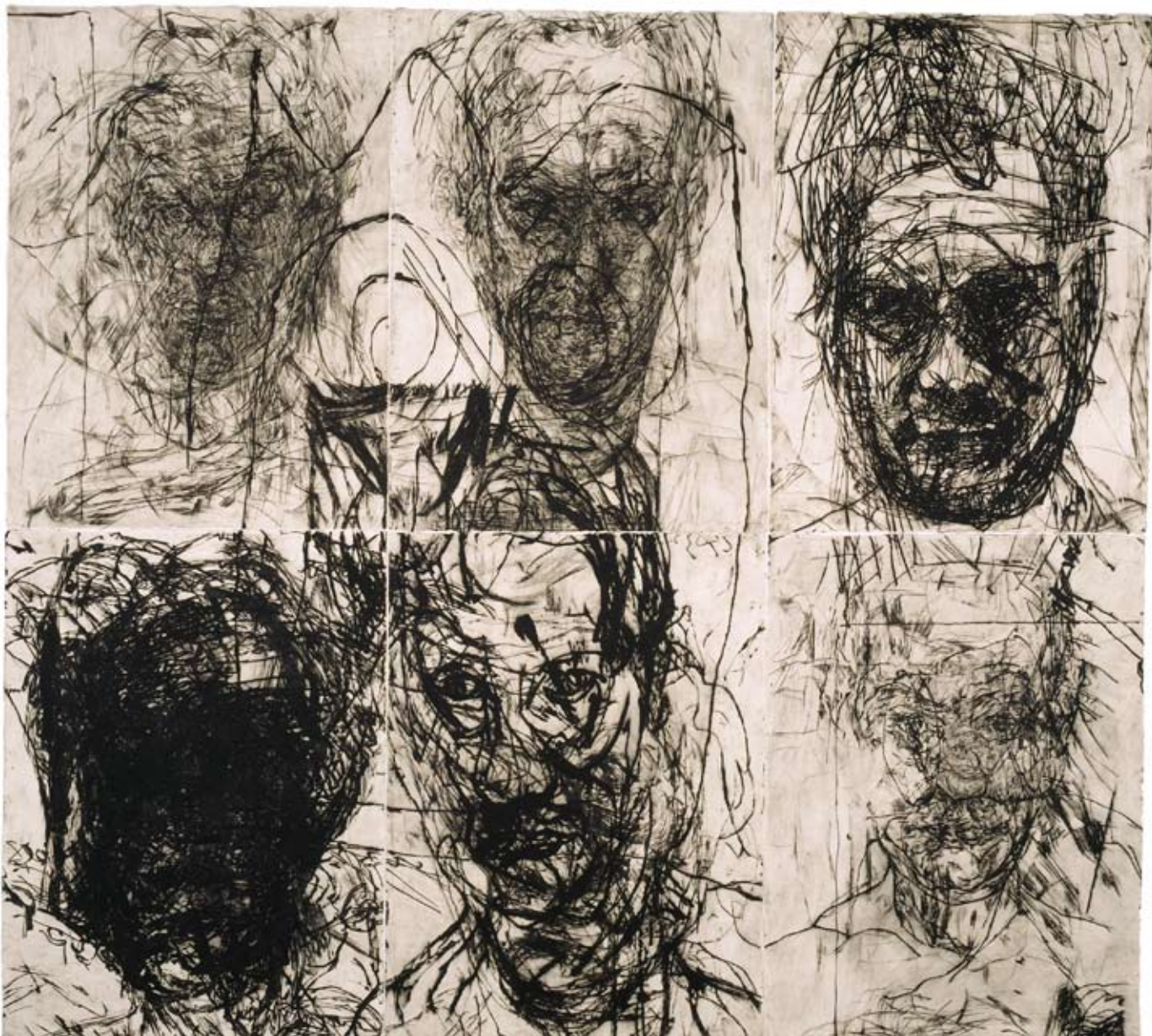
Your application must include:
