NAILS is a new idea. It is a young adult component of Laborers For Christ, an established, successful program of the Lutheran Church Extension Fund. For more than a quarter of a century the Laborers have dedicated their talents to over 750 projects.

Traditionally, Laborers For Christ workers have been retired individuals who work as project consultants, preconstruction coordinators, project managers, and laborers—building churches, schools, parish halls, retirement homes, camp facilities, day care centers, and other structures for the LCMS. Participants have worked for congregations throughout the United States to help them save money on their building projects, while witnessing to their faith in Jesus Christ and living out their Christian commitment.

Laborers For Christ is now reaching out to the Concordia Universities and seminaries, inviting their students to participate in the NAILS Program.
