Reimbursement of Expenses

Congregations are expected, as part of our life together in the Synod, to support the work of the Synod financially and, as called upon from time to time, by permitting their pastors, teachers, and lay people to serve the Synod as members of boards and commissions.

When pastors, teachers, and laypersons are asked to serve, the Synod will assume the expense of travel, lodging, and meals and other incidentals connected with such service. However, in view of the commitment of congregations to support the work of the Synod, the Synod will not pay for the casual service rendered in a non-salaried position, nor pay for any substitutes which may need to be engaged while the pastor, teacher, or layperson is away from his or her position because of service to the Synod. In such instances, if financial outlay is required to perform the duties of the position involved, it is expected that congregations will assume responsibility for such expense.

When individuals are asked whether they are willing to be nominated for a position, this expectation should be taken into consideration to help guide them in deciding whether or not they are able to accept such responsibility.
