Overview of levels

Level A1 | Getting started

Learn easy expressions and sentences and use them to describe the basics in conversations – like where you live and your hobbies.

Level A2 | Communicating basic information

You can get your ideas across and describe your immediate needs – like when you go shopping.

Level B1 | Preparing for everyday life

You can handle most situations that you face, for example, when travelling through Germany. In addition, you can recount different experiences and incidents and express your opinion.

Level B2 | Convincing in discussion

You can communicate spontaneously and fluently – even in longer discussions with native speakers. You understand the main content from complex narratives and discussions and can offer your opinion on abstract topics.

Level C1 | Communicating routinely

You can discuss topics without having to search for words. You understand long, challenging narratives and can use the German language in your free time, job, studies or training.

Level C2 | Mastering challenges without any problems

You understand nearly everything that you read and hear. You can express yourself at will very fluently and can present information extensively.
