Ring Size Finder

General Tips


- Measure you finger in warm temperatures at the end of the day
- When considering a wide band, move up a size from your measurement, for comforts sake
- Your ring size will be about half a size larger on your primary hand (the hand you write with)
- Different countries have different ring-size systems. All sizes listed here are standard UK sizes and alphabetical
- Our system is based on an increase of 1.25mm for each size increase

Note: For accurate ring-size results, you must make sure that you **do not** select the option to fit to page or to shrink to page

Method A

Measure a ring that fits you (or your intended recipient)

Place a ring that fits over the circle, making sure the inside of the ring lines up with the outside of the circle. If you are between sizes, order the larger size.



Method B

Measure your finger and compare to the scale

- Find a piece of non-stretchy string about 6 inches long, or a strip of paper about 6 inches long and ¼ inch wide
- Wrap it snugly around the base of your finger
- Lay the string or paper against a ruler and measure the length in millimetres
- Compare the length of the string or paper to the list below to determine your ring size. If you are between sizes, order the larger size.
