## Ring Size Finder

## General Tips

- Measure you finger in warm temperatures at the end of the day
- When considering a wide band, move up a size from your measurement, for comforts sake
- Your ring size will be about half a size larger on your primary hand (the hand you write with)
- Different countries have different ring-size systems. All sizes listed here are standard UK sizes and alphabetical
- Our system is based on an increase of 1.25 mm for each size increase

Note: For accurate ring-size results, you must make sure that you do not select the option to fit to page or to shrink to page

## Method A

Measure a ring that fits you (or your intended recipient)
Place a ring that fits over the circle, making sure the inside of the ring lines up with the outside of the circle. If you are between sizes, order the larger size.


## Method B

## Measure your finger and compare to the scale

- Find a piece of non-stretchy string about 6 inches long, or a strip of paper about 6 inches long and $1 / 4$ inch wide
- Wrap it snugly around the base of your finger
- Lay the string or paper against a ruler and measure the length in millimetres
- Compare the length of the string or paper to the list below to determine your ring size. If you are between sizes, order the larger size.
